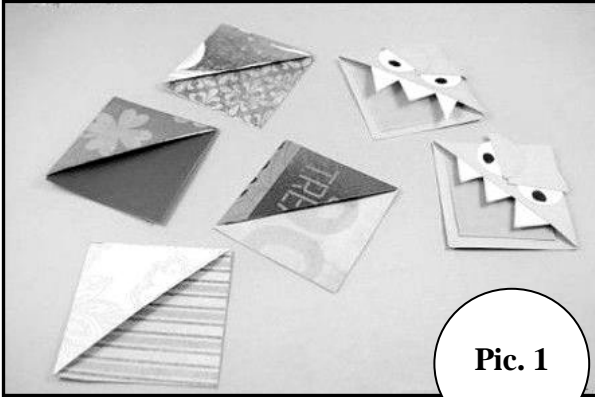

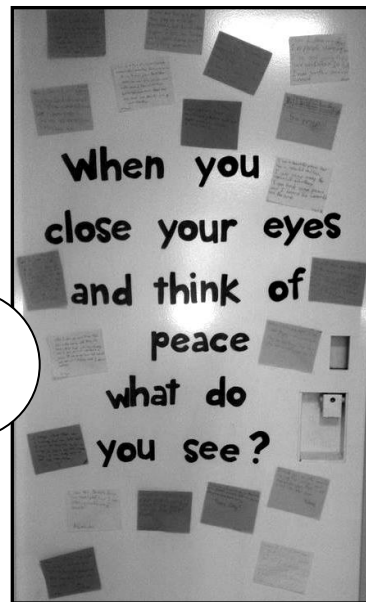

**Who is it? (Fun Game)**

1. Ask children to bring their baby photos. Children guess who's who.
2. Record each child's voice. Children listen to the voices and guess which voice goes with each child.
3. Play "Guess Who". Pick a child out of the classroom. Tell three clues about the person and have the children guess who the person is.

**Friendship quilt (Fun Activity)**

Cut several squares of brightly coloured cardboard. Give each child one of the squares. Have them decorate the square or even glue a picture of themselves, glitter, beads, sequins, wool etc to the square. Staple the squares, side by side to make a 'quilt' and hang it up.

**Other Fun Games:**

- Musical Chair
- Balloon bop Game (The task is to keep two balloons in the air for a specified number of hits without letting it hit the ground.)

- Indoor Basket Ball (All the students have to do is get a bin or bucket and some rolled up balls of newspaper to the 'balls' in the bin)

**Debate on Children's day (Fun Activity)**

Have a classroom debate on a child-centered topic, 'Children's Day should be a national holiday'.

Students will give their opinions and reasons on the topic.

**Other Fun Games:**

- Rope skipping (This may consist of one participant turning and jumping the rope, or a minimum of three participants taking turns, two of whom turn the rope while one or more jumps.)
- Blind game
- With The Help Of One Hand  
For each player (there must be not more than 4 of them) there is a heap of many small and some big objects. The task is to carry all of them in one hand to the distance of 5-7 meters being blindfolded. The players mustn't hold the objects with the other hand or drop them on the floor. The player who covers the distance first becomes the winner.
- Land, Water  
This is a game for attentive players. On hearing the word "land" the players jump forward, on hearing the word "water" backward. Then the word "land" is suddenly changed into "bank". The actions of the players must be the same as after the word "land". The word "water" may be changed into "sea", "lake", "river", etc. The player who often makes mistakes is out.
